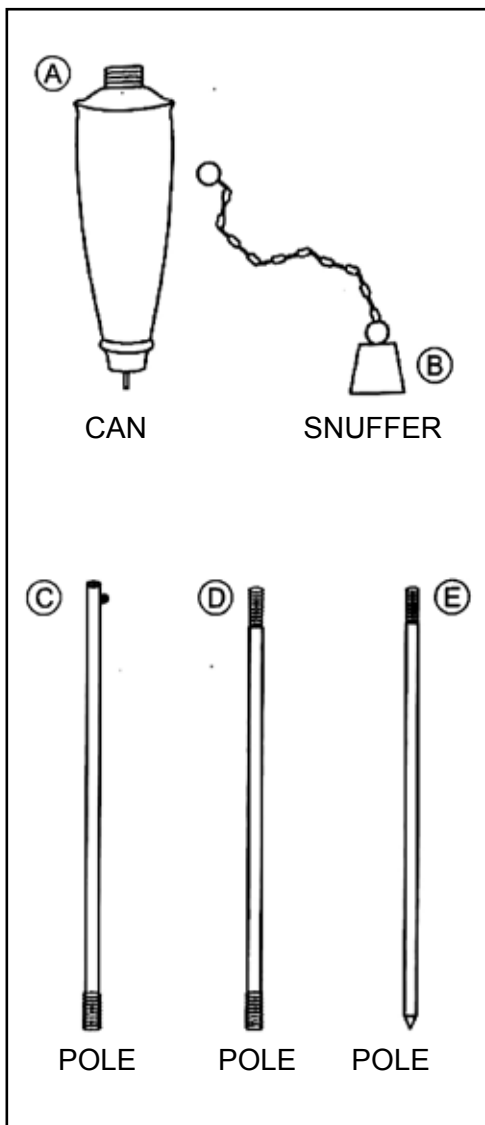


SGST SHOTGUN SHELL PATIO TORCH ASSEMBLY MANUAL

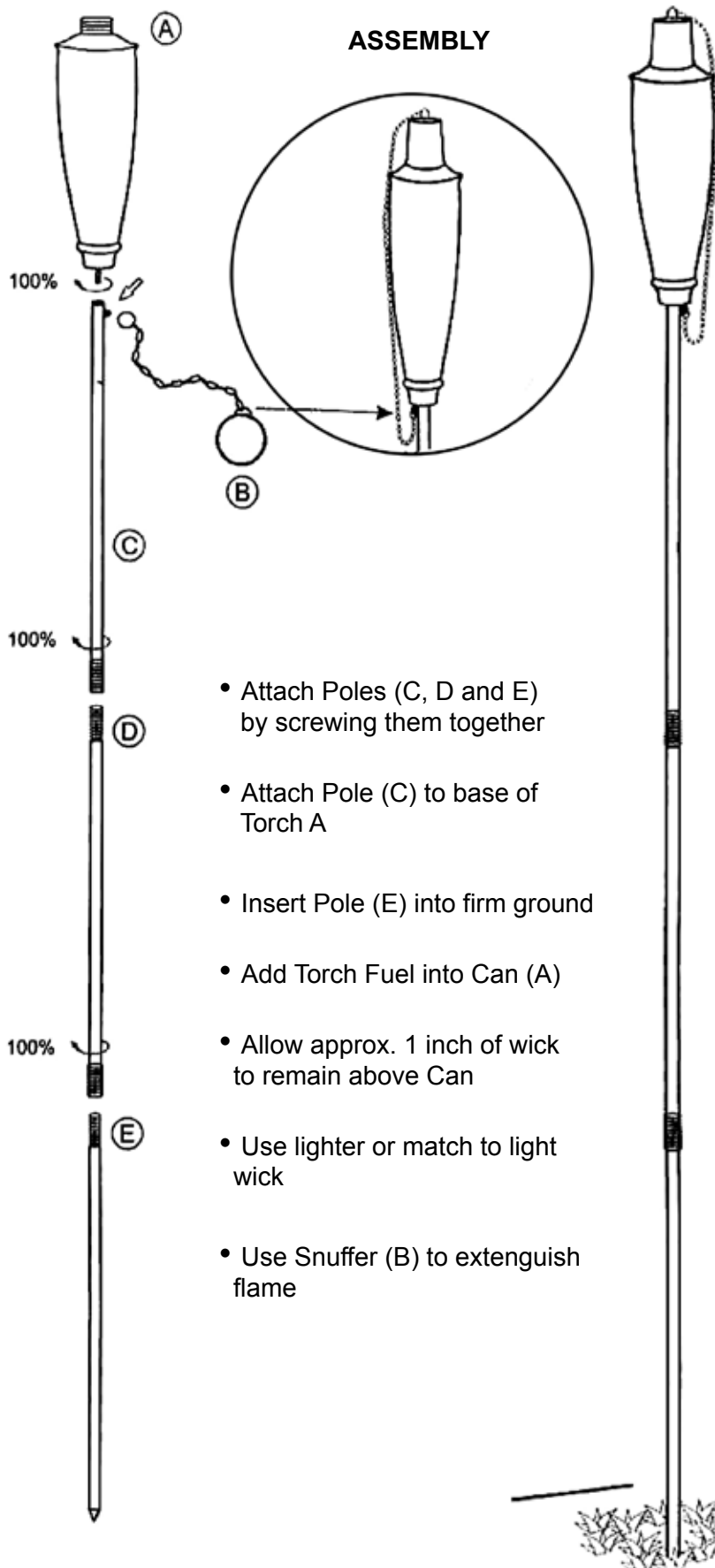
PARTS

- 1 Piece Each :
A, B, C, D, E



FEATURES

- Realistic shotgun 12GA shell design
- 8" canister is 100% steel & won't rust
- Weather resistant finish
- Durable construction
- 8" fiberglass wick is long lasting
- Includes snuffer cap and chain



- Attach Poles (C, D and E) by screwing them together
- Attach Pole (C) to base of Torch A
- Insert Pole (E) into firm ground
- Add Torch Fuel into Can (A)
- Allow approx. 1 inch of wick to remain above Can
- Use lighter or match to light wick
- Use Snuffer (B) to extenguish flame

SGST SHOTGUN SHELL PATIO TORCH SAFETY GUIDELINES

IMPORTANT: READ ALL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USE

WARNINGS AND USER INSTRUCTIONS

- Do not leave children unattended as ingesting lamp oil may lead to serious health consequences. If oil is swallowed, do not induce vomiting, but seek medical advice immediately. (See Oil Bottle)
- The lamp must be filled with a maximum of 75% Oil. In case the volume capacity is not mentioned on product, capacity is measured by filling the lamp completely and then emptying the contents into a measuring jug.
- Use funnel for filling of the Lamp oil into the torch head.
- DO NOT USE HIGHLY FLAMMABLE FUEL SUCH AS PETROL, GASOLINE, SPIRIT, THINNER etc.,
- ALWAYS USE HIGH GRADE "LAMP OIL" or "TIKI TORCH OIL" of reputed brands.
- Always place the product out of reach of children and pets. Please note this product is for outdoor use only.
- Keep away from flammable material
- Light the torch with electric lighter and keep hands & hair away from flame.
- Spillage of lamp oil on the outside of the product should be removed before use.
- Due to the risk of soot damage, do not place close to light colour walls.
- Do not place torches underneath low hanging plants or branches to reduce risk of accidental fires.
- Place torches in open visible areas of yard or party space where they are easily visible to everyone and less likely to be knocked over.
- Ensure torch is firmly in the ground so that winds do not blow torch over. Always place it in upright position.
- Torch includes a snuffer for extinguishing flame when the torch is not in use. To extinguish the flame, hold the cap firmly over the flame until it is out.
- Empty the fuel from Torch into a safe fuel container before storing the torch. DO NOT STORE TORCH WITH THE LAMP OIL/FUEL IN IT.
- Ensure that the wick top is firmly screwed into the lamp before using the product. Check the threads on the wick top line up to the lamp before attaching in a clockwise direction.
- Polish and clean the product parts by polishing and wiping with a soft cloth.
- We recommend methylated spirits to be used on the steel work.
- Methylated spirits can be used to remove soot on the product and gives a protective layer. Apply a thin layer with a cloth, leave for five minutes and wipe off with a dry cloth.
- Avoid using strong cleaning agents. Avoid scratching, denting or damage to the product.

REFILLING THE PATIO TORCH

- Remove the Snuffer from Nozzle
- Take the Nozzle along with the Wick out of torch head. Do not remove the Wick from Nozzle
- Fill the Lamp oil using Funnel or some bottles have inbuilt funnels in them.
- Fill oil to the level marked on the torch can (75%). Do not overfill.
- Now put the nozzle along with the wick rotating CLOCKWISE.
